BOARDING POLICY

- All boarders must be patients of New York Cat Hospital and/or be able to document veterinary examination within the prior 6 months. Boarders will otherwise receive a full exam – at owner’s expense – prior to admission to the boarding ward.
- For the health and safety of other boarding cats and the staff, all cats must be current on immunizations for Rabies and FVRCP (Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia) unless specifically exempted by Dr. Soboroff.
- Cats showing evidence of potentially contagious disease will be isolated from other boarding cats, and receive treatment deemed appropriate by New York Cat Hospital. All such treatment will be at owner’s expense.
- All male cats must be neutered before boarding.
- All cats must be free of external parasites (fleas & ticks) when admitted for boarding, or will be treated at owner’s expense upon admission.
- Cats will be admitted & discharged **ONLY** during regular office hours.
- Any cat that requires emergency or immediate veterinary attention will receive it at our discretion, and at the owner’s expense. Cats requiring medication or treatment will be charged appropriate fees.
- Emergency contact persons and telephone number should be left with the hospital.
- Boarding cats are fed a high-quality, palatable, and easily digestible diet. Should your cat desire or require a specific or prescription food, please provide enough food for the duration of his/her stay.
- Our basic boarding includes the best quality environment away from your home that is available in the area. Your pet will be fed quality food, provided fresh water twice daily, and housed in a controlled, spacious facility. In the facility, your pet will receive individual attention from our qualified hospital staff, who is dedicated to providing the best care possible. Your satisfaction and your pet’s well-being are our primary concern.
- All clients are required to read and sign the boarding policy and admission forms.
